The Mental Health Consultant/Registered Psychiatric Nurse/Registered Nurse provides case management and assessment and treatment to help achieve and maintain optimum mental health in the community. The successful candidate will provide consultative and referral services for professional medical staff and social workers, by providing community based outreach support services, in order to ensure compliance with treatment, safety of the community, and full utilization of existing resources.

We are looking for a Registered Psychiatric Nurse, Registered Nurse or Social Worker with 3 years experience. You will have the following knowledge, skills and abilities:

- Excellent counseling skills and knowledge in the areas of mental illness, domestic violence, sexual assault, child abuse/incest, grief and suicide interventions
- Ability to provide crisis intervention in such areas as suicide risk assessment, mental status exams, critical incident stress debriefing
