Automobile Expenses

Members are instructed to file a grievance if employer refuses to provide T- 2200 form

On the apparent advice from the Canada Revenue Agency, some health sector employers are refusing to provide members with a T-2200 form for the purpose of claiming automobile expenses on their income tax return.

If you require a T-2200 and your employer is refusing to provide you with the form, you must file a grievance. Please contact your steward.

If the proposed tentative provincial collective agreement is ratified, the problem should not repeat next year for community nurses who are required to use their personal vehicles for work. Their new monthly car allowance included in the agreement would be taxable, and employers would be required to provide the T-2200 beginning with the 2006 taxation year.
